

Wildlife Hazard Management Training Gainesville Regional Airport



Blue Wing Environmental (BWE) provided wildlife hazard management training services for Gainesville Regional Airport (GNV). GNV currently operates under a Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) approved Wildlife Hazard Management Plan (WHMP). BWE's FAA Qualified Airport Wildlife Biologist conducted training for airport personnel who participate in the GNV Wildlife Hazard Management Program. The training was conducted to meet the requirements of FAA regulations under 14 CFR Part 139 and guidance provided in FAA Advisory Circular 150/5200-36A.
